Special needs planning was given a big boost when two new bills became law: The ABLE Act and the Military Survivor Benefit Plan. The ABLE account allows an SSI recipient the opportunity to hold funds in an account (up to \$100,000) without interfering with SSI or Medicaid eligibility.
